PRACTICE ROUNDS GUIDELINES (REVISED as of Dec. 03, 2008)

To give more chances for participants to avail of practice rounds, the following revised Practice Round Guidelines will be observed:

1. **GREEN FEES** - Each participant will be allowed one (1) FREE practice round per golf course to be played. If he opts to play more than one (1) practice round he will be required to pay green fees as follows:

PHP800.00 (weekdays); PHP1,000.00 (weekends) – inclusive of insurance

2. **PRACTICE ROUNDS FORMAT**

- a. **DATES:**

SENIORS - 17 and 18 FEBRUARY 2009
MEN'S REGULAR - 23 and 24 FEBRUARY 2009

- b. **TIME:** - **2 SHOTGUN STARTS PER DAY PER COURSE**

0600H and 1200H

- c. **HOLE ASSIGNMENTS :** - ONE (1) TEAM PER HOLE (2 FLIGHTS)
- SENIORS DIV AS FOURSOMES/MENS DIV AS FIVESOMES

3. **GUIDELINES:**

- a. **RESERVATIONS**

➤ Teams may reserve their shotgun starting time and hole assignments during office hours from 8:30am to 5:30 pm Philippine Time starting 15 January 2009 on a **FIRST-COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS;**

➤ Reservations for both golf courses must be coordinated directly with:

- b. **LATE TO START** – Teams that are late to start may join the practice rounds at the position reserved for them. However, for the 0600H morning groups that have started late, they **MUST** stop play at 1200H no matter where they are or how many holes they have played to clear the course for the afternoon groups.
- c. **PICK-UP** – To speed up play players **MUST** pick-up after double bogey for the Seniors Division and bogey for the Men's Division
- d. **VACANT FLIGHTS** - Teams with less than their full allocation of players should allow the club starters to fill in the vacant flights.
- e. **GOLF CARTS** – Golf carts may be used in all Practice Rounds of the Men's and Seniors Division.
- f. **TEAMS BASED IN THE LOCALITY OF THE VENUE ARE REQUESTED TO SCHEDULE THEIR PRACTICE ROUNDS ON OTHER DATES TO GIVE OTHER TEAMS A CHANCE TO PRACTICE.**

PAL SENIORS INTERCLUB GOLF TOURNAMENT

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. RULES OF GOLF

The PAL Seniors Interclub shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews (R&A) and the Local Rules of the Tournament and its Host Clubs.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

2-1 TEAM REQUIREMENTS – A team must fulfil the following requirements to be able to join the PAL Seniors Interclub:

- a. Local Teams must represent a golf club that has its own 18-hole golf course. A team that no longer has a golf course continues to be eligible provided it has not been disqualified and it continues to meet other eligibility requirements.
- b. International teams must meet entry requirements set by the Tournament Committee.

2-2 TEAM ELIGIBILITY – Participation in the tournament shall be limited to:

- a. Teams that have completed play and have not been disqualified in the last PAL Seniors Interclub.
- b. Teams that have been reinstated and new teams accepted by the Tournament Committee.

2-3 INDIVIDUAL PLAYER'S ELIGIBILITY – To be eligible to play in the PAL Seniors Interclub, a player must fulfil the following requirements:

- a. Be at least 55 years old. Players turning 55 in the calendar year of the tournament are eligible to join.
- b. Be included in the Roster of Members of his Club which was submitted to the Tournament Committee during the First Team Captains Meeting.
- c. Fulfil the Travel Requirements of Philippine Airlines. (see Appendix II)

2-4 REJECTION OF ENTRIES – The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject the application of any team or any member of a team seeking entry into the Interclub.

2-5 DISQUALIFICATION/SUSPENSION FROM THE INTERCLUB – At any time, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify and/or suspend any team or individual from their participation in the Interclub. Reasons for dismissal/suspension may include gross disrespect to the sponsors and tournament officials and staff, unbecoming conduct and gross violations of the Rules of Golf and golf etiquette by team member/s during the current or past Interclubs.

3 TEAM CAPTAIN

3-1 DESIGNATION - Each team must have a designated Team Captain who will represent his team in meetings, press conferences and all dealings with the Tournament Committee.

3-2 RESPONSIBILITIES - The Team Captain shall be responsible for the following:

- a. Attend both the First and Second Team Captains Meetings or, if he cannot attend, make sure his team is represented. *Penalty for failure to attend: Team Disqualification*
- b. Submit two (2) sets of the Roster of Members of his Club on the day of the First Team Captains Meeting. *Penalty for failure to submit: Team Disqualification*
- c. Coordinate with his local Philippine Airlines Branch/District Office and ensure that all team members have adhered to the travel policies set forth by the Tournament Committee. *Penalty for failure to follow Travel Policies: Team Disqualification*
- d. Submit the final Team Line-Up with the First Names and Nicknames/Aliases of the members of the team properly indicated before 11:00am on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting. *Note: The team will automatically be classified in the Championship Division if the Team Line-Up is submitted after 11:00am.*
- e. Pay the required entry fees on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting. *Penalty for failure to pay: Team Disqualification*
- f. Check the Roster of Members that was submitted by his club during the First Team Captains Meeting and make sure that all the players listed in the Team Line-Up are included in the Roster. *Penalty for fielding Ineligible Player: Team Disqualification*
- g. Inform all of his team members about the Rules of the Tournament and Conditions of Competition and any changes/additions that have been made.
- h. Submit his list of players to the starters within 30 minutes before the scheduled tee time of his teams' first player to tee-off.

3-3 ADVICE - The Team Captain is not allowed to give advice to any member of his team while they are playing their stipulated rounds. *Penalty for each breach: Two (2) points deduction from the team score for the day.*

3-4 A Team Captain is not allowed to act as team captain for one team then play for another. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

4 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

4-1 FORMAT - The PAL Seniors Interclub is a 36-hole Stroke Play, Modified Stableford, Team Competition played over four (4) days among teams representing golf clubs. Individual awards will also be given.

4-2 POINT SYSTEM - The player's gross scores shall be converted to the following corresponding Points:

Score	Points
Triple Bogey or worse	0
Double Bogey	1
Bogey	2
Par	3
Birdie	4
Eagle	5
Hole-in-One	6
Double Eagle	7

4-3 TEAM COMPETITION

- a. VENUES - The tournament shall be played simultaneously on two (2) golf courses. A team must play two (2) rounds on each golf course.
- b. CLASSIFICATION – Teams shall be classified into four divisions according to Team Averages that are based on the individual PAL Point Average (PPA) of the members of the team. The PPA shall be based on the past performances of the team members over the last five (5) PAL Interclub tournaments. The team divisions are:

Championship Division

Founders Division

Sportswriters Division

Friendship Division

- i. Teams that have been disqualified for violations of the rules in past Interclubs will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division the first year they are allowed to rejoin the Interclub.
 - ii. The Rules on Classification of Teams are further defined in Appendix I.
- c. TEAM SCORES
 - i. A team is given Four (4) playing slots in each playing day and the best Three (3) scores will count as the team score for the day.
 - ii. The team scoring the highest number of points in their division after Four (4) days of play shall be declared champion of their division.
 - iii. The Championship Division may be won by any of the competing teams. A team in a lower division that scores a higher number of points than the teams in the Championship Division shall be declared the overall champion.
- d. 36-HOLE MAXIMUM - A player can only play a maximum of 36 holes.

4-4 INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION –

- a. Players shall be divided into the following divisions based on their PAL Point Average (PPA). They will compete in these flights regardless of what division their team plays in:

Flight A	90 & above PPA + those w/o PPA
Flight B	80 to 89 PPA
Flight C	70 to 79 PPA
Flight D	69 PPA and below

- b. The players who score the highest points after all participants have completed 36-holes of play shall be declared champions of their Flight.
- c. To win any of the Individual Awards a player must play both courses. Players who play both their rounds on the same golf course will only compete for the Best 18-hole Score on that course.

5 TEAM COMPOSITION

5-1 The PAL Seniors Interclub is a golf competition for men.

5-2 Professional golfers whether Touring or Teaching Professionals are not allowed to play in the tournament. Non-amateurs may participate if they are allowed to do so by the Tournament Committee.

5-3 A team may consist of 6, 7 or 8 players.

5-4 ROSTER OF MEMBERS – All participating clubs will be required to submit their Roster of Members on the day of First Team Captains Meeting.

- a. A team will be disqualified if it fails to submit its Clubs' Roster of Members on the designated date.
- b. No changes or additions will be allowed once the Roster has been submitted except in case of Rule 5.4c below.
- c. Teams that need to add names to their Roster after the First Team Captains Meeting may do so by writing a letter to the Tournament Committee before the 31st of January. If the Tournament Committee allows the addition, the club will automatically be assigned to the Championship Division. No changes will be allowed after the 31st of January.

5-5 A player can play for only one (1) team. *Penalty: Disqualification of the succeeding team/s the player has played for*

6 DISQUALIFICATION/SUSPENSION

6-1 TEAM DISQUALIFICATION – Disqualification of a team shall mean the disqualification of all its members and their scores will no longer be counted in the determination of team and individual standings. Grounds for disqualification of a team shall be the following:

- a. Non-attendance of a Team Captain or his representative during both the First and Second Team Captains Meeting.
- b. Failure to submit the Clubs' Roster of Members on the day of the First Team Captains Meeting.
- c. Fielding an ineligible player. An ineligible player shall be defined as:
 - i. A player whose name does not appear in the Roster of Members that the club had submitted during the First Team Captains Meeting.
 - ii. A player whose addition to the Roster has not been approved by the Tournament Committee.
 - iii. A player who has already played 36-holes.
 - iv. A player who has played for another team in an earlier round.
 - v. A player who has assumed another persons identity.
 - vi. A player who has not fulfilled the travel requirements of Philippine Airlines.
- d. Fielding more than 8 players.
- e. Fielding less than 3 players on any day of the competition.
- f. Non-payment of the entry fee on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting.
- g. Commission of gross violations of the Rules and/or Etiquette that the Tournament Committee feels warrant a penalty of Disqualification.

6-2 INDIVIDUAL DISQUALIFICATION – Disqualification of any player under the Rules of Golf in the first round he has played shall not be effective for the second round unless the Tournament Committee determines otherwise.

6-3 SUSPENSION OF DISQUALIFIED TEAMS - A team that has been disqualified for violation of Interclub Rules shall be suspended from participation in the next PAL Interclub and must reapply to be accepted to join succeeding Interclub's. However, the Tournament Committee may waive the suspension for reasons it may deem proper.

7 PAIRINGS AND TEE-TIMES

7-1 Pairings and Starting times for the first two days of play shall be based on team averages. Pairings and starting times for the third and final days of play shall be based on scores which will reflect team standings.

7-2 Pairings shall indicate team names only. Team Captains should provide the starters with the names of their players within 30 minutes before the scheduled tee time of his first player to tee-off. Changes may still be made before the players tee-off except when Rule 7.3 below is being implemented.

7-3 At the option of the Committee, it may require that team captains submit their tee-time assignments in sealed envelopes. Tee- time assignments will be deemed final once these sealed envelopes have been submitted to the starters.

7-4 The Committee reserves the right to alter the pairings and tee-times if it feels that such actions are for the good of the tournament. Players who refuse to follow such changes will be disqualified.

8 REQUESTS FOR TEE TIMES/PLAYING DATES

The Tournament Committee will not entertain any requests for tee times or playing dates. Players who join the tournament should be ready to play on any of the dates and tee-times assigned to them by the Committee.

9 LATE TO TEE

A player is late to tee if he is not on the tee, ready to play, when the starter calls the first player in his flight to the tee. The late player is not disqualified. He will score zero (0) points on the hole/s that he failed to play and he will be allowed to join his assigned group on the tee of the next hole to be played.

10 SLOW PLAY

10-1 All players must maintain the proper Pace of Play at all times. If a flight falls behind by having an open hole in front of them, they will be warned by an official and asked to speed up play and keep pace with the flight ahead.

10-2 If they do not, in the opinion of the official, make a conscious effort to speed up play in the next few holes, the official will time all members of the flight.

10-3 The official doing the timing shall be the sole judge of when it is the players turn to play. Any player who takes more than one (1) minute to play his shot from the time it is his turn to play shall incur a BAD TIME and be subject to the following penalties:

First BAD TIME	Warning
Second BAD TIME	One-Stroke Penalty

Third BAD TIME

Two-Strokes Penalty

Fourth BAD TIME

Disqualification

10-4 The flight will be timed until they have regained their proper position on the course.

10-5 A player will carry his bad time for the rest of the round in case their flight falls out of position again.

11 STOPPING AT THE CLUBHOUSE/TEE HOUSES

Players are not allowed unduly delay play by stopping at the clubhouse/tee houses then sit down, order food and drinks and have refreshments. *Penalty for Breach: Disqualification*

12 CELLULAR PHONES

Cellular phones should be placed on silent mode and should not be used during play of a hole.

13 CADDIES, UMBRELLA BOYS/GIRLS

13-1 Only caddies and umbrella boys/girls accredited by the host clubs may be employed.

13-2 Players are not allowed to caddy for other players. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

14 GOLF BALLS/GOLF CLUBS

Only golf balls and golf clubs which conform to the Rules of Golf shall be used during the tournament. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

15 PICK-UP

To promote faster play, a player who no longer has any chance to score a point on a hole MUST pick-up his ball and discontinue play of the hole. He shall score zero (0) points for the hole and MUST mark his score on that hole with an "X" to indicate a pick-up.

Note: 1. Signing for a score higher than double bogey shall mean that the player has made such a score and he will be subject to the penalty clause of this rule.

2. The disqualification of the player does not free the team from the penalties of this rule.

Penalty for Breach: 2 points deduction from the team score for the day.

However, the team penalty will not apply if:

- a. The Committee determines after the game that the player had incurred a penalty stroke and the player was not aware of the penalty when he holed out on the hole in question;
- b. The player is in doubt as to procedure and/or penalty strokes and the matter has to be referred to the Committee after the game.

16 SCORECARDS/MARKERS

16-1 **MARKER** - Each player shall be assigned by the Committee as a marker to record the scores of another player in the same flight. The marker **MUST** do the recording of scores himself and **NOT THE CADDIE**. *Penalty for breach: Two (2) strokes for each violation*

16-2 **GROSS SCORE** - The marker shall record the GROSS SCORE of the player and mark pick-ups with an "X". *Note: The Committee may disqualify the marker if it is shown that he has deliberately violated this rule and/or deliberately performed actions so another player may be disqualified*

16-3 **SUBMISSION** – The scorecard is deemed to have been submitted when it is dropped in the Drop Box provided for.

16-4 TO AVOID PENALTIES, PLAYERS ARE REMINDED TO:

- a. Retrieve their scorecard from their marker **IMMEDIATELY** after they leave the putting green of their last hole;
- b. Check their scorecards for correctness and make sure that their GROSS SCORES are legibly indicated on the card. Holes picked-up must be marked with an "X";
- c. Settle any doubtful points with the marker and/or the Committee before signing the scorecard. Any alterations in scores on the scorecard must be cleared and clarified with the Scorers before submission. Scores not legibly written will be interpreted by the Committee at its sole discretion;
- d. Make sure the marker has signed the scorecard;
- e. Return the scorecard to the Committee before any member of any flight following them has submitted their scorecard/s or within fifteen (15) minutes of holing out if they are the last flight of the morning or afternoon set. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification*

17 TEAM AWARDS

17-1 The Champion Team shall take possession of the permanent PAL Trophy for one year while the members of the team shall receive medals. A team that wins the permanent trophy for three (3) consecutive years shall be allowed to keep the championship trophy.

17-2 The Champions of the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions as well as the First and Second Runners-up shall be awarded trophies while the members of the teams shall receive medals.

18 INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

18-1 Trophies will be awarded to the Champion, First Runner-Up and Second Runner-up of each of the Flights.

18-2 SPECIAL AWARDS – The following Special Awards will be given:

Hole-in-One

Highest 18-hole Points Scored on each course

19 TIES

19-1 TEAM COMPETITION – Ties in the team competition shall be settled by comparing scores and determining the winner on the basis of:

- a. The final day score of the Fourth player, then by
- b. The total team score of the last 54-holes, then by
- c. The total team score over the last 36-holes, then by
- d. The total team score over the last 18-holes, then by
- e. Drawing of lots

19.2 INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION – Ties in the individual competition shall be settled by comparing scores and determining the winner on the basis of:

- a. The best 18-hole score of the players, then by
- b. The second round played by the players, then by
- c. Drawing of lots

20 CLOSE OF COMPETITION

The competition shall be deemed closed when the Championship Trophy of the division concerned has been awarded to the winner.

21 TOURNAMENT LOCAL RULES

These Tournament Local Rules shall be in effect for all venues of the PAL Seniors Interclub:

21-1 GOLF CARTS – If golf carts cannot be provided for all participants, only players sixty (60) years old and above will be allowed to use golf carts. *Penalty for breach: Two strokes for each hole at which the breach occurred. Maximum penalty: Four strokes. Repeated breach thereafter: Disqualification.*

21-2 EMBEDDED BALL – Rule 25-2 is expanded to include all areas “through the green”.

“ A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.”

21-3 TIME OF STARTING – The five minute allowance for late to tee is NOT IN EFFECT. The player is disqualified for the holes he missed and may join his assigned group on the tee of the next hole to be played.

21-4 STONES IN BUNKER – The local rule allowing the removal of stones in a bunker is NOT IN EFFECT unless the Tournament Committee announces otherwise.

21-5 DISTANCE MEASURING EQUIPMENT – The use of distance measuring equipment during play in the tournament is NOT ALLOWED.

21-6 PRACTICE ON COURSE NOT PLAYED – Players may practice on any course that they have not played subject to the availability of tee-times.

21-7 DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE – In order to speed up play, players are advised to invoke Rule 3-3 (Doubt as to Procedure) whenever they are doubtful of their rights or the correct procedure they must follow. They must complete play of the hole by playing two balls.

22 DEFINITION OF TERMS

22-1 ROSTER OF MEMBERS – The Roster of Members is a list of all the members of the Club.

22-2 TEAM LINE-UP – The Team Line-up is the final list of 6, 7 or 8 members of the Club who will play in the tournament. The Team Line-up MUST be derived from the Roster of Members of the Club.

22-3 PAL POINT AVERAGE (PPA) – The PAL Point Average is the average of the scores of the player in the past five (5) Interclubs. It is used for classification purposes.

23 ADVISORY ON THE RULES

23-1 CADDIES MARKING BALLS – The Rules of Golf allow the player to authorize any person to mark his ball and lift it (Rule 20-1). **Therefore, caddies may be allowed to mark and lift a player's ball.** However, it should be noted that if a player himself marks and lifts his ball, his caddie is not allowed to replace it. If the caddie marks and lifts the ball, the caddie or the player may replace it (Rule 20-3a).

23-2 REPLACEMENT OF PLAYERS – Members of the team who have already played a round CANNOT BE REPLACED. The team may be disqualified for fielding more than 8 players if it replaces a player who has already played.

24 EFFECTIVITY

These Rules shall be effective on the 62nd PAL Interclub in Davao City.

APPENDIX I

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION PAL INTERCLUB

CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS

Classification of teams in the PAL Interclub in both the Men's and Seniors Interclub shall be based on the past individual performances of the team members in the last five (5) Interclubs. The classification shall be done in the following manner:

24-1.1 The Tournament Committee shall maintain two (2) Master lists: one for the Men's Interclub and another for the Seniors Interclub. The lists shall contain a tabulation of the past performances of all players over the past 5 Interclubs and indicate their PAL Point Averages (PPA).

24-1.2 Any questions, clarifications or changes on the lists must be cleared with the Tournament Committee before the end of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting. The Master Lists are deemed to be final after the close of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting.

24-1.3 Before the start of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting, all team captains will be required to fill up and submit their line-up sheets listing the names of the players who will compose their team.

24-1.4 The Tournament Committee will refer to the Master List of the appropriate tournament and indicate the PPA of the members of the team who have PAL Point Averages.

24-1.5 FOR THE MEN'S INTERCLUB:

5.1 The Committee computes the team average by taking into consideration the eight (8) highest PPA's of the members of the team.

5.2 Teams that have only 1, 2 or 3 players with PPA's, teams that have added players to their Roster of Members and reinstated teams will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division. The remaining teams will be ranked according to their average PPA and initially grouped following this distribution:

Championship Division	Top 10% of remaining teams
Founders Division	Next 20%
Sportswriters	Next 30%
Friendship Division	Rest of the teams

5.3 The team classification shall be arrived at after the following adjustments:

- a. Teams with seven (7) players with PPA's shall retain their classification.
- b. Teams in the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions with 4, 5 or 6 players with PPA's shall be promoted to the next higher division.

24-1.6 FOR THE SENIORS INTERCLUB:

6.1 The Committee computes the team average by taking into consideration the six (6) highest PPA's of the members of the team.

6.2 Teams that have only 1 or 2 players with PPA's, teams that have added players to their Roster of Members and reinstated teams will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division. The remaining teams will be ranked according to their average PPA and initially grouped following this distribution:

Championship Division	Top 10% of remaining teams
-----------------------	----------------------------

Founders Division	Next 20%
Sportswriters	Next 30%
Friendship Division	Rest of the teams

- 6.3 The team classification shall be arrived at after the following adjustments:
- a. Teams with five (5) players with PPA's shall retain their classification.
 - b. Teams in the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions with only 3 or 4 players with PPA's shall be promoted to the next higher division.

24-1.7 Team classification may change whenever a team makes any changes in its line-up and the Tournament Committee has evaluated such changes. However, no team shall be reclassified to a lower division as a result of changes in the line-up of a team.

24-1.8 New teams which meet the above conditions shall be assigned to the divisions to which they are eligible. Except that teams which have been disqualified in past Interclubs because of violations of Interclub rules shall automatically be assigned to the Championship Division the first year that they are accepted back into the Interclub.

24-1.9 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to classify or reclassify any team/s at any time or in any manner it deems fit if it thinks that such actions are for the good of the tournament.

APPENDIX II

TRAVEL GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

(Rules to take effect on the 62nd PAL Interclub Golf Tournament in Davao City)

1. Travel Requirements / Privileges

- 1.1 To be eligible, all team members of International Teams must embark/disembark from their state or country of foreign origin. (U.S. teams from the U.S., Australian Teams from Australia, etc.)
- 1.2 Travel to and from the venue of the PAL Interclub Golf Tournament **MUST** be made on Philippine Airlines.
- 1.3 Philippine Airlines will issue Team Captain's complimentary airline tickets for their attendance in the Team Captain's Meeting and the tournament proper. The issuance of these complimentary tickets will be subject to the provision (3) hereunder.
- 1.4 Team members are provided special discounted fares on Philippine Airlines from their point of origin to the venue of the tournament.
- 1.5 A Player may bring along one (1) traveling companion whose travel fares shall be at the same discounted rate as the player. The ticket of the player and his companion must have the same routing and must be purchased from the same PAL Ticket Office but not necessarily at the same time. Companion may only avail of the special fare after purchase of the player/participant's ticket.
- 1.6 Player traveling on non-revenue PAL tickets (ID00/ID75/AD75 or Award Tickets) may play in the tournament but their scores will not be counted.
- 1.7 Players traveling to the tournament venue using other airline tickets are deemed ineligible and are disqualified from participating in the tournament.

2. Travel Period

- 2.1 Discounted tickets will be available for purchase one (1) month before the start of the tournament and will be valid for use within the travel period defined by Philippine Airlines.
- 2.2 A member of a team arriving in the Philippines within **six (6) months** prior to the tournament shall be deemed to be qualified provided that he is listed in the Team's Roster of Members, and provided that the Tournament Committee is given evidence that his travel to and from his home team's state or country of origin has been made on Philippine Airlines. Such evidence shall be the actual unused portion of his return PAL air ticket as well as the proof of arrival based on the passport arrival stamp of the player. PAL PNB ticket Office is the designated ticket office to issue domestic Interclub tickets to the qualified players. **Failure to provide such evidence shall be declined issuance of the domestic Interclub ticket likewise will be considered an eligible player.**

3. Rules on Complimentary Ticket Privilege for Team Captains

- 3.1 The Team Captain's complimentary ticket to the 1st Team Captain's Meeting shall be issued only upon Secretariat's receipt of the team's completed TP FORM-1 on a given deadline. Failure to submit TP FORM-1 on the specified date will result to the non-issuance of complimentary team captain's ticket and will forfeit team's participation to the upcoming Interclub tournament.
- 3.2 The Team Captain's complimentary ticket to the tournament proper is to be issued only when the required number of tickets for each team is confirmed to have been purchased.

- a. The Senior Division Team Captain's complimentary tickets can only be issued when the purchase of a minimum of six (6) tickets for the team has been confirmed.
 - b. Complimentary ticket for a Regular Men's Division Team Captain can only be issued when the purchase of a minimum of eight (8) tickets has been confirmed for the team.
 - c. If a player is competing in both divisions, his ticket will only be counted as a purchased ticket in the Senior Division.
- 3.3 The complimentary tickets may be assigned to another member of the team provided he will:
- a. Register during the 1st Team Captains Meeting
 - b. Submit two (2) original copies of the Team Roster
 - c. Fill-up and submit all required Interclub forms with correct/updated info
 - d. Relay to the team captain, all issues discussed during the 1st Team Captain's Meeting,

4. Special Excess Baggage Charged for Golfing Equipment of non-SportsPlus Member Participant

- 4.1 Transpacific route (piece system): A special charge of US\$50.00 for the golfing equipment (not exceeding 15kgs) each way or US\$100 round trip from the point of origin to the venue of the tournament and vice versa.
- 4.2 Regional and Domestic route (weight system): Ten (15kgs) kilos free baggage allowance each way or twenty (30kgs) round trip from the point of origin to the venue of the tournament and vice versa.

5. Rule on Surface Travel

Local Teams who are based close to the venue of the tournament are allowed to travel by land or sea ferry. However, team members are required to purchase round-trip discounted tickets on PAL to any one local destination during the tournament period. These tickets will be valid for travel within one year from date issue (with block-out periods).

6. Travel Privileges of the Host Club Teams

The registered members of the teams of the host clubs may avail of special discounted fares on Philippine Airlines from their point of origin to Manila or vice versa. The discounted ticket should be purchased during the tournament period and the tickets will be valid for travel within one year from date issue (with block-out periods).

7. Rebooking Fees

The rebooking fees for a one-time change of flight schedule of tournament participants is waived. Subsequent changes will be charged the normal rebooking fees.

PAL MEN'S INTERCLUB GOLF TOURNAMENT

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. RULES OF GOLF

The PAL Men's Interclub shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews (R&A) and the Local Rules of the Tournament and its Host Clubs.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

2-1 TEAM REQUIREMENTS – A team must fulfil the following requirements to be able to join the PAL Men's Interclub:

- a. Local Teams must represent a golf club that has its own 18-hole golf course. A team that no longer has a golf course continues to be eligible provided it has not been disqualified and it continues to meet other eligibility requirements.
- b. International teams must meet entry requirements set by the Tournament Committee.

2-2 TEAM ELIGIBILITY – Participation in the tournament shall be limited to:

- a. Teams that have completed play and have not been disqualified in the last PAL Men's Interclub.
- b. Teams that have been reinstated and new teams accepted by the Tournament Committee.

2-3 INDIVIDUAL PLAYER'S ELIGIBILITY – To be eligible to play in the PAL Men's Interclub, a player must fulfil the following requirements:

- a. Be included in the Roster of Members of his Club which was submitted to the Tournament Committee during the First Team Captains Meeting.
- b. Fulfil the Travel Requirements of Philippine Airlines. (see Appendix II)

2-4 REJECTION OF ENTRIES – The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject the application of any team or any member of a team seeking entry into the Interclub.

2-5 DISQUALIFICATION/SUSPENSION FROM THE INTERCLUB – At any time, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify and/or suspend any team or individual from their participation in the Interclub. Reasons for dismissal/suspension may include gross disrespect to the sponsors and tournament officials and staff, unbecoming conduct and gross violations of the Rules of Golf and golf etiquette by team member/s during the current or past Interclubs.

3 TEAM CAPTAIN

3-1 DESIGNATION - Each team must have a designated Team Captain who will represent his team in meetings, press conferences and all dealings with the Tournament Committee.

3-2 RESPONSIBILITIES - The Team Captain shall be responsible for the following:

- a. Attend both the First and Second Team Captains Meetings or, if he cannot attend, make sure his team is represented. *Penalty for failure to attend: Team Disqualification*
- b. Submit two (2) sets of the Roster of Members of his Club on the day of the First Team Captains Meeting. *Penalty for failure to submit: Team Disqualification*
- c. Coordinate with his local Philippine Airlines Branch/District Office and ensure that all team members have adhered to the travel policies set forth by the Tournament Committee. *Penalty for failure to follow Travel Policies: Team Disqualification*
- d. Submit the final Team Line-Up with the First Names and Nicknames/Aliases of the members of the team properly indicated before 11:00am on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting. *Note: The team will automatically be classified in the Championship Division if the Team Line-Up is submitted after 11:00am.*
- e. Pay the required entry fees on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting. *Penalty for failure to pay: Team Disqualification*
- f. Check the Roster of Members that was submitted by his club during the First Team Captains Meeting and make sure that all the players listed in the Team Line-Up are included in the Roster. *Penalty for fielding Ineligible Player: Team Disqualification*
- g. Inform all of his team members about the Rules of the Tournament and Conditions of Competition and any changes/additions that have been made.
- h. Submit his list of players to the starters within 30 minutes before the scheduled tee time of his teams' first player to tee-off.

3-3 ADVICE - The Team Captain is not allowed to give advice to any member of his team while they are playing their stipulated rounds. *Penalty for each breach: Two (2) points deduction from the team score for the day.*

3-4 A Team Captain is not allowed to act as team captain for one team then play for another. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

4 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

4-1 FORMAT - The PAL Men's Interclub is a 36-hole Stroke Play, Modified Stableford, Team Competition played over four (4) days among teams representing golf clubs. Individual awards will also be given.

4-2 POINT SYSTEM - The player's gross scores shall be converted to the following corresponding Points:

Score	Points
Double Bogey or worse	0
Bogey	1
Par	2
Birdie	3
Eagle	4
Hole-in-One	5
Double Eagle	6

4-3 TEAM COMPETITION

- a. **VENUES** - The tournament shall be played simultaneously on two (2) golf courses. A team must play two (2) rounds on each golf course.
- b. **CLASSIFICATION** – Teams shall be classified into four divisions according to Team Averages that are based on the individual PAL Point Average (PPA) of the members of the team. The PPA shall be based on the past performances of the team members over the last five (5) PAL Interclub tournaments. The team divisions are:

Championship Division

Founders Division

Sportswriters Division

Friendship Division

- i. Teams that have been disqualified for violations of the rules in past Interclubs will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division the first year they are allowed to rejoin the Interclub.
 - ii. The Rules on Classification of Teams are further defined in Appendix I.
- c. **TEAM SCORES**

- i. A team is given Five (5) playing slots in each playing day and the best Four (4) scores will count as the team score for the day.
 - ii. The team scoring the highest number of points in their division after Four (4) days of play shall be declared champion of their division.
 - iii. The Championship Division may be won by any of the competing teams. A team in a lower division that scores a higher number of points than the teams in the Championship Division shall be declared the overall champion.

- d. 36-HOLE MAXIMUM - A player can only play a maximum of 36 holes.

4-4 INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION –

- a. Players shall be divided into the following divisions based on their PAL Point Average (PPA). They will compete in these flights regardless of what division their team plays in:

Flight A	60 & above PPA + those w/o PPA
Flight B	50 to 59 PPA
Flight C	40 to 49 PPA
Flight D	39 PPA and below

- b. The players who score the highest points after all participants have completed 36-holes of play shall be declared champions of their Flight.
- c. To win any of the Individual Awards a player must play both courses. Players who play both their rounds on the same golf course will only compete for the Best 18-hole Score on that course.

5 TEAM COMPOSITION

5-1 The PAL Men's Interclub is a golf competition for men.

5-2 Professional golfers whether Touring or Teaching Professionals are not allowed to play in the tournament. Non-amateurs may participate if they are allowed to do so by the Tournament Committee.

5-3 A team may consist of 8, 9 or 10 players.

5-4 ROSTER OF MEMBERS – All participating clubs will be required to submit their Roster of Members on the day of First Team Captains Meeting.

- a. A team will be disqualified if it fails to submit its Clubs' Roster of Members on the designated date.
- b. No changes or additions will be allowed once the Roster has been submitted except in case of Rule 5.4c below.
- c. Teams that need to add names to their Roster after the First Team Captains Meeting may do so by writing a letter to the Tournament Committee before the 31st of January. If the Tournament Committee allows the addition, the club will automatically be assigned to the Championship Division. No changes will be allowed after the 31st of January.

5-5 A player can play for only one (1) team. *Penalty: Disqualification of the succeeding team/s the player has played for*

6 DISQUALIFICATION/SUSPENSION

6-1 TEAM DISQUALIFICATION – Disqualification of a team shall mean the disqualification of all its members and their scores will no longer be counted in the determination of team and individual standings. Grounds for disqualification of a team shall be the following:

- a. Non-attendance of a Team Captain or his representative during both the First and Second Team Captains Meeting.
- b. Failure to submit the Clubs' Roster of Members on the day of the First Team Captains Meeting.
- c. Fielding an ineligible player. An ineligible player shall be defined as:
 - i. A player whose name does not appear in the Roster of Members that the club had submitted during the First Team Captains Meeting.
 - ii. A player whose addition to the Roster has not been approved by the Tournament Committee.
 - iii. A player who has already played 36-holes.
 - iv. A player who has played for another team in an earlier round.
 - v. A player who has assumed another persons identity.
 - vi. A player who has not fulfilled the travel requirements of Philippine Airlines.
- d. Fielding more than 10 players.
- e. Fielding less than 4 players on any day of the competition.
- f. Non-payment of the entry fee on the day of the Second Team Captains Meeting.
- g. Commission of gross violations of the Rules and/or Etiquette that the Tournament Committee feels warrant a penalty of Disqualification.

6-2 INDIVIDUAL DISQUALIFICATION – Disqualification of any player under the Rules of Golf in the first round he has played shall not be effective for the second round unless the Tournament Committee determines otherwise.

6-3 SUSPENSION OF DISQUALIFIED TEAMS - A team that has been disqualified for violation of Interclub Rules shall be suspended from participation in the next PAL Interclub and must reapply to be accepted to join succeeding Interclub's. However, the Tournament Committee may waive the suspension for reasons it may deem proper.

7 PAIRINGS AND TEE-TIMES

7-1 Pairings and Starting times for the first two days of play shall be based on team averages. Pairings and starting times for the third and final days of play shall be based on scores which will reflect team standings.

7-2 Pairings shall indicate team names only. Team Captains should provide the starters with the names of their players within 30 minutes before the scheduled tee time of his first player to tee-off. Changes may still be made before the players tee-off except when Rule 7.3 below is being implemented.

7-3 At the option of the Committee, it may require that team captains submit their tee-time assignments in sealed envelopes. Tee- time assignments will be deemed final once these sealed envelopes have been submitted to the starters.

7-4 The Committee reserves the right to alter the pairings and tee-times if it feels that such actions are for the good of the tournament. Players who refuse to follow such changes will be disqualified.

8 REQUESTS FOR TEE TIMES/PLAYING DATES

The Tournament Committee will not entertain any requests for tee times or playing dates. Players who join the tournament should be ready to play on any of the dates and tee-times assigned to them by the Committee.

9 LATE TO TEE

A player is late to tee if he is not on the tee, ready to play, when the starter calls the first player in his flight to the tee. The late player is not disqualified. He will score zero (0) points on the hole/s that he failed to play and he will be allowed to join his assigned group on the tee of the next hole to be played.

10 SLOW PLAY

10-1 All players must maintain the proper Pace of Play at all times. If a flight falls behind by having an open hole in front of them, they will be warned by an official and asked to speed up play and keep pace with the flight ahead.

10-2 If they do not, in the opinion of the official, make a conscious effort to speed up play in the next few holes, the official will time all members of the flight.

10-3 The official doing the timing shall be the sole judge of when it is the players' turn to play. Any player who takes more than one (1) minute to play his shot from the time it is his turn to play shall incur a BAD TIME and be subject to the following penalties:

First BAD TIME	Warning
Second BAD TIME	One-Stroke Penalty
Third BAD TIME	Two-Strokes Penalty
Fourth BAD TIME	Disqualification

10-4 The flight will be timed until they have regained their proper position on the course.

10-5 A player will carry his bad time for the rest of the round in case their flight falls out of position again.

11 STOPPING AT THE CLUBHOUSE/TEE HOUSES

Players are not allowed unduly delay play by stopping at the clubhouse/tee houses then sit down, order food and drinks and have refreshments. *Penalty for Breach: Disqualification*

12 CELLULAR PHONES

Cellular phones should be placed on silent mode and should not be used during play of a hole.

13 CADDIES, UMBRELLA BOYS/GIRLS

13-1 Only caddies and umbrella boys/girls accredited by the host clubs may be employed.

13-2 Players are not allowed to caddy for other players. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

14 GOLF BALLS/GOLF CLUBS

Only golf balls and golf clubs, which conform to the Rules of Golf shall be used during the tournament. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification of player*

15 PICK-UP

To promote faster play, a player who no longer has any chance to score a point on a hole MUST pick-up his ball and discontinue play of the hole. He shall score zero (0) points for the hole and MUST mark his score on that hole with an "X" to indicate a pick-up.

Note: 1. Signing for a score higher than Bogey shall mean that the player has made such a score and he will be subject to the penalty clause of this rule.

2. The disqualification of the player does not free the team from the penalties of this rule.

Penalty for Each Breach: 2 points deduction from the team score for the day.

However, the team penalty will not apply if:

- a. The Committee determines after the game that the player had incurred a penalty stroke and the player was not aware of the penalty when he holed out on the hole in question;
- b. The player is in doubt as to procedure and/or penalty strokes and the matter has to be referred to the Committee after the game.

16 SCORECARDS/MARKERS

16-1 MARKER - Each player shall be assigned by the Committee as a marker to record the scores of another player in the same flight. The marker MUST do the recording of scores himself and NOT THE CADDIE. *Penalty for breach: Two (2) strokes for each violation*

16-2 GROSS SCORE - The marker shall record the GROSS SCORE of the player and mark pick-ups with an "X". *Note: The Committee may disqualify the marker if it is shown that he has deliberately violated this rule and/or deliberately performed actions so another player may be disqualified*

16-3 SUBMISSION – The scorecard is deemed to have been submitted when it is dropped in the Drop Box provided for.

16-4 TO AVOID PENALTIES, PLAYERS ARE REMINDED TO:

- a. Retrieve their scorecard from their marker IMMEDIATELY after they leave the putting green of their last hole;
- b. Check their scorecards for correctness and make sure that their GROSS SCORES are legibly indicated on the card. Holes picked-up must be marked with an "X";
- c. Settle any doubtful points with the marker and/or the Committee before signing the scorecard. Any alterations in scores on the scorecard must be cleared and

clarified with the Scorers before the card is submitted. Scores not legibly written will be interpreted by the Committee at its sole discretion;

- d. Make sure the marker has signed the scorecard;
- e. Return the scorecard to the Committee before any member of any flight following them has submitted their scorecard/s or within fifteen (15) minutes of holing out if they are the last flight of the morning or afternoon set. *Penalty for breach: Disqualification*

17 TEAM AWARDS

17-1 The Champion Team shall take possession of the permanent PAL Championship Trophy for one year while the members of the team shall receive medals. A team that wins the permanent trophy for three (3) consecutive years shall be allowed to keep the championship trophy.

17-2 The Champions of the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions as well as the First and Second Runners-up shall be awarded trophies while the members of the teams shall receive medals.

18 INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

18-1 Trophies will be awarded to the Champion, First Runner-Up and Second Runner-up of each of the Flights.

18-2 SPECIAL AWARDS – The following Special Awards will be given:

Hole-in-One

Highest 18-hole Points Scored on each course

19 TIES

19-1 TEAM COMPETITION – Ties in the team competition shall be settled by comparing scores and determining the winner on the basis of:

- a. The final day score of the Fifth player, then by
- b. The total team score of the last 54-holes, then by
- c. The total team score over the last 36-holes, then by
- d. The total team score over the last 18-holes, then by
- e. Drawing of lots

19.2 INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION – Ties in the individual competition shall be settled by comparing scores and determining the winner on the basis of:

- a. The best 18-hole score of the players, then by
- b. The second round played by the players, then by
- c. Drawing of lots

20 CLOSE OF COMPETITION

The competition shall be deemed closed when the Championship Trophy of the division concerned has been awarded to the winner.

21 TOURNAMENT LOCAL RULES

These Tournament Local Rules shall be in effect for all venues of the PAL Men's Interclub:

21-1 GOLF CARTS – Players are NOT allowed to ride in motorized transportation unless authorized by the Tournament Committee. *Penalty for breach: Two strokes for each hole at which the breach occurred. Maximum penalty: Four strokes. Repeated breach thereafter: Disqualification.*

21-2 EMBEDDED BALL – Rule 25-2 is expanded to include all areas “through the green”.

“ A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer to the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.”

21-3 TIME OF STARTING – The five minute allowance for late to tee is NOT IN EFFECT. The player is disqualified for the holes he missed and may join his assigned group on the tee of the next hole to be played.

21-4 STONES IN BUNKER – The local rule allowing the removal of stones in a bunker is NOT IN EFFECT unless the Tournament Committee announces otherwise.

21-5 DISTANCE MEASURING EQUIPMENT – The use of distance measuring equipment during play in the tournament is NOT ALLOWED.

21-6 PRACTICE ON COURSE NOT PLAYED – Players may practice on any course that they have not played subject to the availability of tee-times.

21-7 DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE – In order to speed up play, players are advised to invoke Rule 3-3 (Doubt as to Procedure) whenever they are doubtful of their rights or the correct procedure they must follow. They must complete play of the hole by playing two balls.

22 DEFINITION OF TERMS

22-1 ROSTER OF MEMBERS – The Roster of Members is a list of all the members of the Club.

22-2 TEAM LINE-UP – The Team Line-up is the final list of 8, 9 or 10 members of the Club who will play in the tournament. The Team Line-up MUST be derived from the Roster of Members of the Club.

22-3 PAL POINT AVERAGE (PPA) – The PAL Point Average is the average of the scores of the player in the past five (5) Interclubs. It is used for classification purposes.

23 ADVISORY ON THE RULES

23-1 CADDIES MARKING BALLS – The Rules of Golf allow the player to authorize any person to mark his ball and lift it (Rule 20-1). **Therefore, caddies may be allowed to mark and lift a player's ball.** However, it should be noted that if a player himself marks and lifts his ball, his caddie is not allowed to replace it. If the caddie marks and lifts the ball, the caddie or the player may replace it (Rule 20-3a).

23-2 REPLACEMENT OF PLAYERS – Members of the team who have already played a round CANNOT BE REPLACED. The team may be disqualified for fielding more than 10 players if it replaces a player who has already played.

24 EFFECTIVITY

These Rules shall be effective on the 62nd PAL Interclub in Davao City.

APPENDIX I

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION PAL INTERCLUB

CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS

Classification of teams in the PAL Interclub in both the Men's and Seniors Interclub shall be based on the past individual performances of the team members in the last five (5) Interclubs. The classification shall be done in the following manner:

24-1.1 The Tournament Committee shall maintain two (2) Master lists: one for the Men's Interclub and another for the Seniors Interclub. The lists shall contain a tabulation of the past performances of all players over the past 5 Interclubs and indicate their PAL Point Averages (PPA).

24-1.2 Any questions, clarifications or changes on the lists must be cleared with the Tournament Committee before the end of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting. The Master Lists are deemed to be final after the close of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting.

24-1.3 Before the start of the 2nd Team Captains Meeting, all team captains will be required to fill up and submit their line-up sheets listing the names of the players who will compose their team.

24-1.4 The Tournament Committee will refer to the Master List of the appropriate tournament and indicate the PPA of the members of the team who have PAL Point Averages.

24-1.5 FOR THE MEN'S INTERCLUB:

5.1 The Committee computes the team average by taking into consideration the eight (8) highest PPA's of the members of the team.

5.2 Teams that have only 1, 2 or 3 players with PPA's, teams that have added players to their Roster of Members and reinstated teams will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division. The remaining teams will be ranked according to their average PPA and initially grouped following this distribution:

Championship Division	Top 10% of remaining teams
Founders Division	Next 20%
Sportswriters	Next 30%
Friendship Division	Rest of the teams

5.3 The team classification shall be arrived at after the following adjustments:

- a. Teams with seven (7) players with PPA's shall retain their classification.
- b. Teams in the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions with 4, 5 or 6 players with PPA's shall be promoted to the next higher division.

24-1.6 FOR THE SENIORS INTERCLUB:

6.1 The Committee computes the team average by taking into consideration the six (6) highest PPA's of the members of the team.

6.2 Teams that have only 1 or 2 players with PPA's, teams that have added players to their Roster of Members and reinstated teams will be automatically assigned to the Championship Division. The remaining teams will be ranked according to their average PPA and initially grouped following this distribution:

Championship Division	Top 10% of remaining teams
Founders Division	Next 20%
Sportswriters	Next 30%
Friendship Division	Rest of the teams

6.3 The team classification shall be arrived at after the following adjustments:

- a. Teams with five (5) players with PPA's shall retain their classification.
- b. Teams in the Founders, Sportswriters and Friendship Divisions with only 3 or 4 players with PPA's shall be promoted to the next higher division.

24-1.7 Team classification may change whenever a team makes any changes in its line-up and the Tournament Committee has evaluated such changes. However, no team shall be reclassified to a lower division as a result of changes in the line-up of a team.

24-1.8 New teams which meet the above conditions shall be assigned to the divisions to which they are eligible. Except that teams which have been disqualified in past Interclubs because of violations of Interclub rules shall automatically be assigned to the Championship Division the first year that they are accepted back into the Interclub.

24-1.9 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to classify or reclassify any team/s at any time or in any manner it deems fit if it thinks that such actions are for the good of the tournament.

APPENDIX II

TRAVEL GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

(Rules to take effect on the 62nd PAL Interclub Golf Tournament in Davao City)

1. Travel Requirements / Privileges

- 1.1 To be eligible, all team members of International Teams must embark/disembark from their state or country of foreign origin. (U.S. teams from the U.S., Australian Teams from Australia, etc.)
- 1.2 Travel to and from the venue of the PAL Interclub Golf Tournament **MUST** be made on Philippine Airlines.
- 1.3 Philippine Airlines will issue Team Captain's complimentary airline tickets for their attendance in the Team Captain's Meeting and the tournament proper. The issuance of these complimentary tickets will be subject to the provision (3) hereunder.
- 1.4 Team members are provided special discounted fares on Philippine Airlines from their point of origin to the venue of the tournament.
- 1.5 A Player may bring along one (1) traveling companion whose travel fares shall be at the same discounted rate as the player. The ticket of the player and his companion must have the same routing and must be purchased from the same PAL Ticket Office but not necessarily at the same time. Companion may only avail of the special fare after purchase of the player/participant's ticket.
- 1.6 Player traveling on non-revenue PAL tickets (ID00/ID75/AD75 or Award Tickets) may play in the tournament but their scores will not be counted.
- 1.7 Players traveling to the tournament venue using other airline tickets are deemed ineligible and are disqualified from participating in the tournament.

2. Travel Period

- 2.1 Discounted tickets will be available for purchase one (1) month before the start of the tournament and will be valid for use within the travel period defined by Philippine Airlines.
- 2.2 A member of a team arriving in the Philippines within **six (6) months** prior to the tournament shall be deemed to be qualified provided that he is listed in the Team's Roster of Members, and provided that the Tournament Committee is given evidence that his travel to and from his home team's state or country of origin has been made on Philippine Airlines. Such evidence shall be the actual unused portion of his return PAL air ticket as well as the proof of arrival based on the passport arrival stamp of the player. PAL PNB ticket Office is the designated ticket office to issue domestic Interclub tickets to the qualified players. **Failure to provide such evidence shall be declined issuance of the domestic Interclub ticket likewise will be considered an eligible player.**

3. Rules on Complimentary Ticket Privilege for Team Captains

- 3.1 The Team Captain's complimentary ticket to the 1st Team Captain's Meeting shall be issued only upon Secretariat's receipt of the team's completed TP FORM-1 on a given deadline. Failure to submit TP FORM-1 on the specified date will result to the non-issuance of complimentary team captain's ticket and will forfeit team's participation to the upcoming Interclub tournament.
- 3.2 The Team Captain's complimentary ticket to the tournament proper is to be issued only when the required number of tickets for each team is confirmed to have been purchased.

- a. The Senior Division Team Captain's complimentary tickets can only be issued when the purchase of a minimum of six (6) tickets for the team has been confirmed.
 - b. Complimentary ticket for a Regular Men's Division Team Captain can only be issued when the purchase of a minimum of eight (8) tickets has been confirmed for the team.
 - c. If a player is competing in both divisions, his ticket will only be counted as a purchased ticket in the Senior Division.
- 3.3 The complimentary tickets may be assigned to another member of the team provided he will:
- a. Register during the 1st Team Captains Meeting
 - b. Submit two (2) original copies of the Team Roster
 - c. Fill-up and submit all required Interclub forms with correct/updated info
 - d. Relay to the team captain, all issues discussed during the 1st Team Captain's Meeting,

4. Special Excess Baggage Charged for Golfing Equipment of non-SportsPlus Member Participant

- 4.1 Transpacific route (piece system): A special charge of US\$50.00 for the golfing equipment (not exceeding 15kgs) each way or US\$100 round trip from the point of origin to the venue of the tournament and vice versa.
- 4.2 Regional and Domestic route (weight system): Ten (15kgs) kilos free baggage allowance each way or twenty (30kgs) round trip from the point of origin to the venue of the tournament and vice versa.

5. Rule on Surface Travel

Local Teams who are based close to the venue of the tournament are allowed to travel by land or sea ferry. However, team members are required to purchase round-trip discounted tickets on PAL to any one local destination during the tournament period. These tickets will be valid for travel within one year from date issue (with block-out periods).

6. Travel Privileges of the Host Club Teams

The registered members of the teams of the host clubs may avail of special discounted fares on Philippine Airlines from their point of origin to Manila or vice versa. The discounted ticket should be purchased during the tournament period and the tickets will be valid for travel within one year from date issue (with block-out periods).

7. Rebooking Fees

The rebooking fees for a one-time change of flight schedule of tournament participants is waived. Subsequent changes will be charged the normal rebooking fees.
