



## Declaration of Consent/ Refusal to Receive Medical Observation

- my consent** to be placed under medical observation in a designated room at a facility designated by the Health Bureau.

I understand, under this circumstance, I will be ordered mandatory isolation/quarantine by the SS, under subparagraph 2 of article 15 of Law No. 2/2004 - “Law on the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases”, given that I or my interest parties may appeal to the Court of Second Instance.

**Law No. 2/2004 – Law on the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases**  
**Article 14 Control measures**

1. For persons infected with, suspected to have contracted or at risk of contracting an infectious disease, in order to prevent the spread of the disease, the health authorities may adopt the following measures:
  - 1) to perform medical observation or medical examination at designated time and location;
  - 2) to restrict their undertaking of certain activities or pursuing certain occupations, or to establish conditions for the exercise of those activities or occupations;
  - 3) to carry out mandatory isolation/ quarantine in accordance with the provisions of the following article.
2. The decision of ordering the measures prescribed in the previous subparagraph should be made in writing with indication of reasons, particularly stating the characterization of the disease and the estimated period for implementing the measures.

**Article 15 Mandatory isolation/ quarantine**

1. Persons infected with or suspected to have contracted a category I infectious disease indicated in the annex table of this Law, or persons at risk of contracting those diseases, may be subject to mandatory isolation/ quarantine.
2. People who do not comply with the provisions in item 1) or 2) of subparagraph 1 of the above article can be subject to mandatory isolation/ quarantine, without prejudice to the corresponding criminal responsibility.
3. Within 24 hours after the isolation/ quarantine decision is made, the spouse of, lineal blood ascendant or descendant of, or persons designated by the isolated/ quarantined person should be informed of the decision.
4. Within 72 hours after the isolation/ quarantine decision is made, the said decision and relevant basis should be submitted to the Court of First Instance for confirmation.
5. The isolated/ quarantined person or his interested parties may appeal against the confirmation referred in the previous subparagraph to the Court of Second Instance.
6. The confirmation and appeal mentioned in this article are of urgent nature.
