Letter for Entry into Singapore

Dear **John Tan ABC**,

We would like to inform that your request to enter Singapore from 22 October 2021 to 29 October 2021 has been **approved**, provided you undertake the following measures:

1. You are required to fill in the SG Arrival Card by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority of Singapore (ICA) 72 hours prior to arrival at <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard/>. Please declare if you are a recovered COVID-19 traveller.
2. Print out a **hardcopy** of this letter and show it to the airline staff upon check-in before boarding the plane and at the Singapore Immigration & Checkpoints Authority's (ICA) checkpoint upon arrival in Singapore. Otherwise, you will not be allowed to enter Singapore.
3. All travellers, with the exception of those who remained in the countries in Travel Health Control Category I for 14 consecutive days before departing for Singapore, are required to undergo a COVID-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test conducted within 48 hours prior to their departure for Singapore. You are required to present a valid negative COVID-19 PCR test prior to boarding, and at immigration in Singapore, as a condition of approval to enter Singapore. The negative test results must be clearly stated in English, with the particulars of the traveller in accordance to their passport and the date of the test taken. Travellers without a valid COVID-19 PCR test result will be denied entry into Singapore.

4. All travelers are required to present a physical or electronic copy of the vaccination certificate prior to boarding, and at immigration in Singapore, as a condition of approval to enter Singapore. The country, name and date(s) of vaccination must be clearly stated with the particulars of the traveller in accordance to their passport. If the vaccination certification is not in English, it should be translated to English and notarised. Travellers without a valid vaccination certificate will be denied entry into Singapore.

5. If you are a short-term visitor who requires a visa to enter Singapore, you would need to separately apply for and obtain a valid Singapore visa prior to your departure. Please apply for a visa through a local contact, authorised visa agents or overseas missions/embassies. If you already have an existing valid visa, you need not apply for a new visa. You can check your visa status via <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/esvclandingpage/save>.

6. You will be subjected to temperature screening and a COVID-19 PCR swab test upon arrival (i.e. day 1) in Singapore. You are required to self-isolate in your place of accommodation until the results of the swab test is known. The test results will take approximately 24 hours to be conveyed via SMS. Please ensure that you have provided a valid international phone number or a local line to receive the SMS notification.

7. Travellers are required to download the TraceTogether mobile application on a TraceTogether-compatible mobile phone upon arrival, and to use the application for the duration of their stay in Singapore. If the traveller's mobile device is unable to download the application, they are to rent a mobile device from Changi Recommends:

8. Subsequently you will be subjected to the Enhanced Testing Regime. Travellers are required to take Antigen Rapid Tests (ART) based on the country that they had remained in the 14 consecutive days before departing for Singapore in Travel Health Control Category:

- a. Category I – No ART required
- b. Category II – Day 3 of arrival
- c. Category III – Day 3 and 5 arrival
- d. Category IV – Day 3, 5 and 10 arrival

9. All travellers will be required to take ART before entering the event venue daily. There is no need to take the ART under the Enhanced Testing Regime if the pre-event test falls on Day 3, 5 and 10 of your travel. You are required to bear all medical costs, including PCR and ART tests, incurred for your stay in Singapore, unless advised otherwise.

10. While in Singapore, there will no restriction to movement for travellers who had remained in the countries in Travel Health Control Category I, II and III for 14 consecutive days before departing for Singapore. Travellers who had travelled to countries in Travel Health Control Category IV in the 14 days before departing for Singapore must adhere to the white-listed activities allowed for the delegates of the Bloomberg New Economy Forum 2021.

11. All travellers will need to use pre-arranged private transportation during their stay in Singapore.

12. Please note that health protocols including the testing regime, are subjected to changes. Travellers will be notified should there be changes.

This Letter grants the above-indicated traveller the approval for entry into Singapore, where the approval is non-transferable and is limited to the indicated individual only. Please note that if any of the conditions are found to be breached, your stay in Singapore may be cancelled and action will be taken against you.

As the global COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, we will continue to update our border measures. Travellers planning to enter Singapore should be prepared to be subjected to the prevailing border measures upon entry. The terms and conditions of your entry and stay in Singapore are also subject to changes without prior notice. Travellers should approach the designated liaison officer from Bloomberg closer to date for any updates, if applicable.
