

Toronto Pearson Testing Study Services

Passengers in need of a predeparture COVID-19 test can now receive testing on site at Toronto Pearson International Airport, made available as part of a research study.

Currently Available for Passengers

Panbio Antigen Testing (www.torontopearson.com/testing-antigen)

- Open only to passengers without symptoms of COVID-19
- **Passengers who test positive on Antigen cannot travel and must go to Public Health for PCR confirmatory test**
- **Passengers must have an internet-capable device (such as a smartphone) to access/view their test results – we cannot print results at the testing centre**
- Preregistration encouraged; appointments can be booked up to 2.5 hours before flight time
- Walk ups must arrive 3.5 hours prior to flight time to accommodate registration time, testing time, and time to receive results
- **Pearson Testing Centre Location**
 - Terminal 1, Level 2, South Bridge
- **Pearson Testing Centre Hours of Operation**
 - Monday to Friday, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM
 - Saturday & Sunday, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Getting to the Terminal 1 Testing Centre

From Terminal 1

- Follow signs for “Departures COVID-19 Testing”
- Accessible from the Terminal 1 Parking Garage on Level 5
- Accessible by escalator or elevator from Terminal 1 Level 1 (Arrivals) or Terminal 1 Level 3 (Departures)

From Terminal 3

- Follow signs for Terminal 1 to the Terminal LINK Train platform
- Take the Terminal LINK Train from Terminal 3 to the Terminal 1 station
- Go down the escalators to the Terminal 1 Parking Garage lobby and follow signs for “Departures COVID-19 Testing” that will take you through the Parking Garage to the South Bridge and the testing registration area
