| 8200 | <p>CHILDREN'S AND INFANTS' FARES (Continued)</p> <p>(C) (APPLICABLE FOR TRANSPORTATION OTHER THAN TO/FROM U.S.A. AND CANADA)</p> <p>(1) <u>ACCOMPANIED CHILDREN (INFANT(S)) UNDER TWO YEARS OF AGE</u> When accompanied by an adult passenger (See NOTE), children who are less than two years of age on the date of commencement of the outward journey will be assessed fares as follows: (a) 10 percent of the applicable adult fare for one child (infant) not occupying an individual seat. (b) 75 percent of the applicable adult fare for children under two years of age occupying individual seats or children in excess of one accompanying an adult passenger. NOTE: "Adult Passenger", as used herein shall mean a passenger 12 years of age or older.</p> <p>(2) <u>ACCOMPANIED CHILDREN TWO YEARS OF AGE OR OVER, BUT UNDER 12</u> When accompanied by an adult passenger (See NOTE), children who have reached their second birthday but have not reached their twelfth birthday on the date of commencement of their outward journey, will be assessed 75 percent of the applicable adult fare. EXCEPTION: Between points in the Philippines and Guam, fare will be 75 percent of the applicable adult fare. NOTE: "Adult Passenger", as used herein, shall mean a passenger 12 years of age and older.</p> <p>(3) <u>Unaccompanied children (UM) eight years of age or over but under twelve (12) and are foreign passport/non-Philippine passport holders may avail of the unaccompanied minor service fee.</u> They will be assessed 100 percent of the applicable adult fare. (a) A UM service fee shall be assessed as follows: AU/NZ USD 70/AUD 90/NZD 100 LON: USD 100/GBP 70 AUH/DXB/RUH/DMM/JED/DOH/KWI: USD 75/SAR 370/AED 370/KWI 30 All Others: USD 50 or its equivalent in local currency assessed for travel other than USA/Canada. (b) Unaccompanied minors holding Philippine passport may only avail of this service only upon presentation of a travel clearance from DSMD. (c) UM service fee of PHP 500 for travel within the Philippines.</p> <p>+ [N] (4) <u>Infant turning 2 enroute</u> Infant who turns two (2) years old en-route on the date of departure must be provided a seat. the fare should be reassessed a child's fare for the remaining portion(s) of the journey, but not within the fare component.</p> <p>(5) <u>Other conditions for accompanied/unaccompanied children.</u> Unless otherwise specified in an applicable fares rule, children's and infants' discount apply to any charge or surcharge and any cancellation or refund fee.</p> |
