PREMIUM ECONOMY FEES (Continued)II. PREMIUM ECONOMY TO BUSINESS CLASS UPGRADE FEE

(A) Premium Economy to Business upgrade fee (PBUF) is offered to revenue passengers holding Premium Economy tickets who opt to be seated in the Business Class cabin at the airport on the day of the flight. This shall be available for both domestic and select international travel.

(C) PROCEDURES

(1) International

- (a) Premium Economy to Business Upgrade Fee shall only be offered and sold at the Airport upon check-in on the day of the flight. Not available for web check-in.
- (b) PBUF may be availed by and Premium Economy Class passengers holding or booked on reservations booking designators (RBD) W/N who would want to be seated in the Business Class Cabin.
- (c) Infant without seat shall not be charged. Child/Infant with seat (paying at least 75 percent of the adult fare) shall pay full PBUF.
- (d) Non-Revenue passengers (except industry-discount tickets and agent-discount tickets paying 50 percent of the fare: ID50/AD50) and passengers holding Mabuhay Miles Award ticket are not qualified to avail of the product.
- (e) PBUF is nonrefundable however, in cases of flight disruptions, denied board or other reason wherein the paid fee is not provided (e.g. safety or operational requirements) the said fee may be refunded in full.
- (f) Subject to seat availability.
- (g) Original Mileage shall apply.
- (h) Business Class Free Baggage Allowance shall apply.
- (i) Lounge access.
- (j) No other discount shall apply.

(2) Domestic

- (a) Premium Economy to Business upgrade fee shall only be offered and sold at the airport upon check-in on the day of the flight. Not available for web check-in.
- (b) PBUF may be availed by Premium Economy Class Passengers holding or booked on reservation, booking designator (RBD) W/N who wants to be seated in the Business Class Cabin.
- (c) Infant without seat shall not be charged. Child/Infant with seat (paying at least 75% of the adult fare) shall pay full PEF.
- (d) Non-Revenue passengers (Except industry-discount Tickets and agent-discount tickets paying 50 percent of the fare: ID50/AD50) and passengers holding Mabuhay Miles Award Ticket are not qualified to avail of this product.
- (e) PBUF is nonrefundable however, in cases of flight disruption, denied boarding or other reason (i.e. safety or operational requirement) wherein the paid fee is not provided, the said fee may be refunded in full.
- (f) Subject to seat availability.
- (g) Original mileage shall apply.
- (h) Business Class Free Baggage Allowance shall apply.
- (i) Lounge access shall be allowed
- (j) No other discount shall apply.

(D) BUSINESS CLASS UPGRADE FEE

The Business Class upgrade fee (BCUF) is a fixed rate assessed at the airport embarkation aiming to expedite handling of passengers holding Economy class tickets but wanting to upgrade to business class on the day of the flight. Rates shall apply as follows:
