TICKETS (Continued)

(I) ACCEPTANCE OF TICKETS

(1) Airline Tickets issued outside the Philippines for International Transportation of Passengers originating in the Philippines shall not be valid for such transportation. (See Notes 1 and 2 below)

NOTE 1: For the purpose of this Rule, a Passenger traveling abroad from the Philippines shall be deemed originating in the Philippines if:

- (a) He is a resident of the Philippines; or
- (b) His travel abroad from the Philippines is subject to the payment of the travel tax imposed under PD 1183 as amended; or
- (c) The first leg of his actual trip starts in the Philippines as verified by the absence of the corresponding immigration entry on his passport subsequent to the date of issuance of the airline ticket abroad.

NOTE 2: For the purpose of this Rule, an airline Ticket is deemed issued outside the Philippines if it shows on its face that it has been issued outside the Philippines.

- (2) (a) All airlines operating to/from or through Philippines, including off-line carriers with sales offices and/or general sales agents in Philippines, are hereby prohibited from importing into Philippines airline tickets issued outside Philippines for international air transportation of passengers originating in Philippines.
 - (b) All airlines operating to, from and/or through Philippines shall ascertain whether or not the tickets for international air transportation of passengers originating in the Philippines, presented by such passengers at the airline check-in counters at the Manila International Airport, have been issued outside Philippines. If so, said airlines shall not honor such tickets.
 - (c) PR shall have no obligation to accept for any purposes under this rule passenger tickets or related transportation documents issued by any carrier which is in substantial default of its interline obligations or which voluntarily or involuntarily has become the subject of bankruptcy proceedings. If and when PR accepts such tickets, PR shall have no obligation to make a fare adjustment which would require PR to refund money to the passenger.
- (3) Ticket endorsement is required.

(J) NAME AND ADDRESS OF CARRIER

Carrier's name may be abbreviated in the Ticket. Carrier's address shall be deemed to be the airport of departure shown opposite the first abbreviation of Carrier's name in the "Carrier" box in the Ticket. However, this shall not necessarily be taken to be the place where the Carrier is domiciled or ordinarily resident for purposes of the Convention.

REISSUANCE FEE FOR NAME CHANGES

(A) NAME CHANGES SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR THE FOLLOWING CASES

- (1) To correct spelling, add or delete missing letter of passenger's Surname or First Name.
- (2) To add Maria or MA, to the First Name.
- (3) To correct maiden name to married name.
- (4) Passenger preference to use other name, only if specified in the passport with A.K.A.
- (5) Transposition of foreign name of the passenger provided all name are included.
- (6) To correct gender

(B) REISSUANCE FEE FOR NAME CHANGES SHALL APPLY AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) For point of sale US/CA: USD 25.00/CAD 40.00
- (2) For point of sale Japan: JPY 2,500
- (3) Other point of sale: USD 25.00 or its equivalent in local currency.

(C) Copy of passenger's passport must be presented upon ticket reissuance.

(D) For all other changes not mentioned above, change fee as specified in the fare rules shall apply.
