

RULE	SECTION II - SPECIAL AND PROMOTIONAL FARES AND CHARGES - UNPUBLISHED FARES
8500	<p><u>PASSENGERS ON STRETCHER</u></p> <p>(A) Passengers traveling on a stretcher will be accepted for transportation by the carriers listed below, subject to Rule 25 herein, provided advance arrangements are made and space and appropriate equipment for mounting within the aircraft are available; and subject to the conditions and charges indicated provided that:</p> <p>(1) The cost of ambulances, hospitalization and other ground expenses will be borne by the passenger occupying the stretcher.</p> <p>(2) Except as otherwise provided, the normal free baggage allowance will apply to each fare paid.</p> <p>(B) PR will carry in the Economy Class cabin only an incapacitated passenger on a stretcher furnished by PR, provided advance arrangements are made and space and appropriate equipment for mounting within the aircraft are available, under the following conditions and charges:</p> <p>(1) <u>Application</u>: The fare and charges for passenger requiring stretcher service shall apply for one way travel on each PR international sector.</p> <p>(a) <u>Adult/Child/Infant</u></p> <p>(i) For all international sectors (except for travel between Philippines and Australia). -Fare shall be six hundred percent (600%) of the full normal economy one way fare (regardless of whether the patient is an adult/child or infant). This shall include the patient's fare plus 2 free oxygen tanks.</p> <p>(ii) For travel between Philippines and Australia -Fare shall be five hundred percent (500%) of the full normal economy one way fare (regardless of whether the patient is an adult/child or infant). This shall include the patient's fare, escort plus 2 free oxygen tanks.</p> <p>(iii) †[C] For travel between MNL and Cebu/Davao -Fare shall be nine hundred percent (900%) of the full normal economy one way fare (regardless of whether the patient is an adult/child or infant) plus an additional charge of USD 250.00/CAD 260.00 for one oxygen tank if required. For the required companion a separate fare shall be charged and this shall be the fare applicable to his journey.</p> <p>(iv) <u>Additional Oxygen Tanks</u> -USD 250.00/CAD 260.00 shall be charged for each additional oxygen service that provides an equivalent of 1 additional tank.</p> <p>(v) <u>Companion</u> -For the required companion a separate fare shall be charged and this shall be the fare applicable to his journey.</p> <p>(b) <u>Conditions</u></p> <p>(i) <u>Reservations</u> -Reservations must be made †[C] up to 48 hours before departure.</p> <p>(ii) <u>Penalties</u> -For Changes in Reservations within 24 hours-5% of stretcher fare.</p> <p>(iii) <u>For No-Show</u> -No show surcharge shall be 5% of the stretcher fare. <u>Note</u>: A passenger who does not show up for the flight or fails to cancel his reservation within 24 hours before departure shall be considered a no show.</p> <p>(iv) <u>For Cancellation and Refunds</u> -Standard refund penalties shall apply plus any other applicable penalties.</p> <p>†[N](v) Refunds of additional oxygen tanks once installed in aircraft, oxygen charges are nonrefundable.</p> <p>(2) <u>Attendant</u>: The stretcher passenger must be accompanied by at least one able-bodied attendant who shall care for the stretcher passenger during the trip and must occupy the seat adjoining those occupied by the stretcher passenger.</p> <p>(3) <u>Other Services</u>: Loading and unloading from the aircraft is the responsibility of the attendant and other attendants as may arranged by the passenger at his own expense. The cost of ambulance service, hospitalization and other ground expenses will be borne by the passenger.</p> <p>(4) <u>Interline Transportation</u> On passenger request, PR will assist in making arrangements for the transport of stretcher cases on the other airlines but will do so only as an agent. Where interline carrier has agreed in writing to their carriage.</p> <p>(5) <u>Indemnity Form</u>: PR will require the passenger, his guardian or responsible family member to sign a liability release form to be provided by PR.</p>
