JLE	SECTION I - GENERAL RULES
15	<p><u>ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE OF PASSENGERS AND BAGGAGE</u></p> <p>Passengers and their baggage are subject to inspection with an electronic detector with or without the passengers consent or knowledge.</p>
C16	<p><u>FUEL SURCHARGE</u> (For travel originating Canada) (For tickets issued on/after [C]19JUL18)</p> <p>(A) The following charges shall be collected per direction of travel from each passenger travelling on international sector when travel originates from Canada:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) For travel between Canada and international destinations except Australia, U.S. and Colombo, the charge to be collected shall be CAD 50.00 per direction. (2) For travel to Colombo, the charge to be collected shall be CAD 50.00 per direction. (3) For travel between MNL and Australia/New Zealand/Port Moresby, the charge to be collected is CAD 70 per direction. (4) For travel between MNL and YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 65 for Economy class and CAD 80 for Business class per direction. (5) For travel between MNL and Canada except YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 70 for Economy class and CAD 85 for Business class per direction. (6) For travel between Luzon, Visayans and YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 78 for Economy class and CAD 93 for Business class per direction. (7) For travel between Mindanao and YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 84 for Economy class and CAD 99 for Business class per direction. (8) For travel between Luzon, Visayans and Canada except YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 83 for Economy class and CAD 98 for Business class per direction. (9) For travel between Mindanao and Canada except YVR the charge to be collected is CAD 89 for Economy class and CAD 104 for Business class per direction. (10) For travel between Manila and India, the charge to be collected is CAD 40.00 per sector. (11) For transborder travel between Canada and United States except Hawaii, the charge to be collected is USD 10.00/CAD 10.00 per sector. <p>(B) Should be collected at point of sale and at place of ticket issuance.</p> <p>(C) Surcharge shall be shown as -YQ- in the tax box ticket.</p> <p>(D) Surcharge published in a currency other than CAD, must be converted to NUC using the applicable IATA Rate of Exchange (IROE).</p> <p>(E) The surcharge shall be assessed for ticket reissuance where additional collection is required.</p> <p>(F) The surcharge is not commissionable and amount will accrue to PR.</p> <p>(G) This charge shall apply on all passengers regardless of travel, fare type and category of passengers (CHD/ID/AD, ETC). <u>EXCEPTION:</u> ID tickets for PR staff and their qualified dependent's travel</p> <p>(H) The fuel surcharge shall not apply on PR domestic sectors.</p> <p>(I) Infant without seat (INF) shall be charged 10% of the applicable adult fuel surcharge.</p>
