RULE	SECTION I - GENERAL RULES
C40	<p><u>[C]TAXES</u>            Any tax or charge imposed by government or other authority, or by the operator of an airport, in respect of a Passenger or the use by a Passenger of any services or facilities, will be in addition to the published fares and charges and shall be payable by the Passenger, except as otherwise provided in Carrier's tariff.</p>
41	<p><u>NAVIGATION SURCHARGE</u></p> <p>(A) <u>ORIGINATING PHILIPPINES</u>            (1) A surcharge of CAD 15.00 per direction will be added to the applicable fare for travel for departure of each transpacific sector.  <u>NOTE</u>            The surcharge is a navigation surcharge applicable for transportation to/from Canada.            (2) The navigation surcharge will be collected at the time of ticket issuance for travel between Canada and the United States and for transpacific travel to/from Canada including through passengers with a stopover in Canada exceeding 24 hours. The surcharge of CAD 15.00 applies to all passengers and will apply in each direction.            (3) The amount to be charged will be incorporated in the fare calculation shown as /Q/ surcharge by converting the CAD surcharge amount into NUC using the applicable IATA Rate of Exchange (IROE).            (4) The surcharge applies in addition to all other charges and is not subject to any further discounts.            (5) The navigation surcharge will accrue to PR when travel to/from Canada is via the services of PR.</p> <p>(B) <u>ORIGINATING CANADA/AREA 3</u>            (1) A surcharge of CAD 15.00 per direction will be added to the applicable fare for travel for departure of each transpacific sector.  <u>NOTE</u>            The surcharge is a navigation surcharge applicable for transportation to/from Canada.            (2) The navigation surcharge will be collected at the time of ticket issuance for transpacific travel to/from Canada including through passengers with a stopover in Canada exceeding 24 hours. The surcharge of CAD 15.00 applies to all passengers and will apply in each direction.            (3) The amount to be charged will be incorporated in the fare calculation shown as /Q/ surcharge by converting the CAD surcharge amount into NUC using the applicable IATA Rate of Exchange (IROE).            (4) The surcharge applies in addition to all other charges and is not subject to any further discounts.            (5) The navigation surcharge will accrue to PR when travel to/from Canada is via the services of PR.</p>
